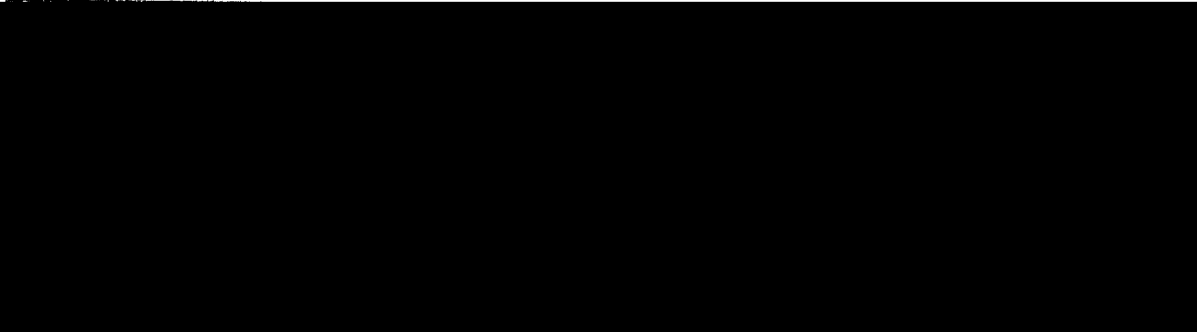

SUBJECT Chinese Communist Action Units in Hong Kong and Macao

1. In late July 1950 the 1 and 2 East River Action Detachments in Hong Kong, under LAI T'ieh (麥鐵) and YANG Tien-yuan (楊殿元) respectively, were planning to confine their activities to observation of the movements of Nationalist guerrilla leaders, and liaison with Communist elements. They were to take no drastic action, at least for the time being. Most of the members of these units are disguised as palmists, fortune-tellers, herb-vendors, and the like, and they loiter in the streets, and in tea-houses and restaurants.
2. The 3 East River Action Detachment in Macao, under HUANG Shang-hsien (黃尚賢), was to create disturbances, such as robberies, and attribute them to Nationalist guerrillas, in the hope that the latter would eventually be driven out by the Macao Government.

25X1X [Redacted] An earlier report from the same informant ascribed to these Action Units the following functions:

- a. Collection of military and political information.
- b. Secret investigation of the activities of anti-Communist guerrilla leaders in Hong Kong and Macao.
- c. Collection of information on the addresses and activities of former outstanding Nationalist military and political personnel in the cities in the lower East River area.

Each unit is said to comprise forty or fifty members.

25X1A [Redacted] Chinese Communist Action Squads in Macao have been reported [Redacted] that 100 special workers had been sent to Hong Kong and Macao to carry on terrorist activities. 25X1A
