1. Major Shevrov, (fnu), was assigned [redacted] at the Hagenow (M 54/T 24) airfield in late June 1950. (1) 25X1

2. Artillery Unit [redacted] at the Ludwigslust (M 54/T 53) airfield was commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Niyeyevich, (fnu), (2) Unit [redacted] commanded by Colonel Sharokha, (fnu), was identified as an engineer unit at the field. Motor vehicles of the unit were stored in a new garage, 5 x 6 meters, and in two hangars each with floor space 100 x 80 meters. The hangars had oil heating installations. (3) A tank unit at the field was commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Grechov, (fnu), and stored its tanks in hangars 6, 7, 8 and 9. These hangars were equipped with boiler plants, each costing 4,700 eastmarks. Construction work cost 173,000 eastmarks. Another tank unit was assigned [redacted]. The CO of the unit was not identified. (4) 25X1

3. Several units were identified in Schwerin (M 54/T 46). Unit [redacted] personnel wearing black epaulets was stationed in the Fritsch Kaserne. It was commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Radion, (fnu). Tank Unit [redacted] commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Kirichenko, (fnu), was stationed in the Moltke Kaserne. Ammunition was stored in the barracks. (5) An artillery battalion, commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Korolov, (fnu), was stationed in the Krueger Kaserne [redacted] and included Major Polahose, (fnu), among its officers. (6) Infantry ammunition of Unit [redacted] stationed in the Adolf-Hitler Kaserne, was stored in the ammunition depot near Zippendorf. Ammunition of Unit [redacted] stationed in the Moltke Kaserne, and commanded by Colonel Korlov, (fnu), was also stored there. (7) 25X1

The tank unit in the Neue Kaserne, commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Trapesnikov, (fnu), was assigned 90,000 eastmarks for the installation of a central heating system in its tank and motor vehicle garages. (8) Major Pluta, (fnu), CO of artillery [Redacted] was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. (9)

[Redacted] "The Soviet salvage party stationed at 47 Bartherstrass [Redacted] was commanded by Figichov, (fnu), whose rank was not known. (10)

6.

A tank unit stationed at the airfield near Perleberg (M 54/T 70) was commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Turayev, (fnu). The unit was supplied with material for the installation of a central heating system in its garages. (11) Tank Unit [Redacted] commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Shichenko, (fnu), had a central heating system constructed in garage 1 and in the former hangar. (12)

7.

Colonel Totopov, (fnu), whose [Redacted] assignment were not known, requested allocation of wood and cement for the construction of an open air theater in Rehrick on the Wustrow Peninsula (M 55/O 51). The theater was to have a capacity of 1,200. (13)

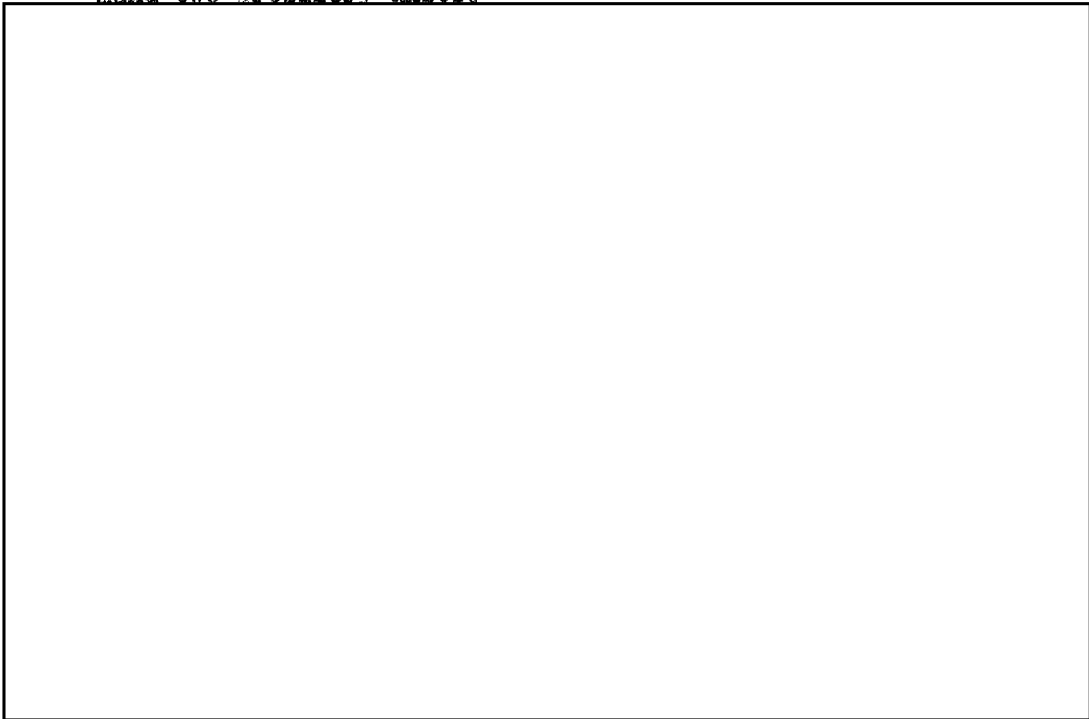
