25X1 1. Twenty-one Pe-2s and four biplanes were counted at Parndorf (P 48/X 77) airfield on 12 July 1950.

25X1 2. Tents were again observed as they were on 9 June 1950 but were arranged differently so that it seemed that another unit had moved to the field. \*

25X1 3. [Redacted]

25X1 \* [Redacted] Comment. According to a previous report the field was occupied by about the same number and the same types of aircraft on 9 June 1950.

25X1 [Redacted] The field was unoccupied on 2 July 1950. The occupation of the field as observed on 12 July 1950 confirms the assumption that, as in the previous year, the field is only temporarily occupied by a bomber regiment for the conduct of air maneuvers. [Redacted]

25X1 [Redacted] as previously observed, the bomber regiment is a unit of the 8th Gds Bwr Div from Strasshof (P 49/S 50).

25X1 \*\* [Redacted] Comment. [Redacted] This radio truck was possibly temporarily detached to Austria for training purposes.
