1. Four jet planes with swept-back wings made practice flights at Brandenburg-Briest (N 53/Z 13) airfield on 18, 19 and 24 July 1950.

2. On 24 July 1950, 20 jet planes with swept-back wings were counted at the field. Two jet fighters were in the air in gusty and cloudy weather. *

3. There was intensive flying at Brandenburg-Briest airfield between 18 and 23 July 1950. Alerts were repeatedly practiced with the siren in operation. ** A radar set was near the Rosenhof, protected by eight light AA guns. ***

25X1 ** Comment. It has been previously reported that the unit stationed at the field is alerted. [redacted]
