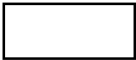
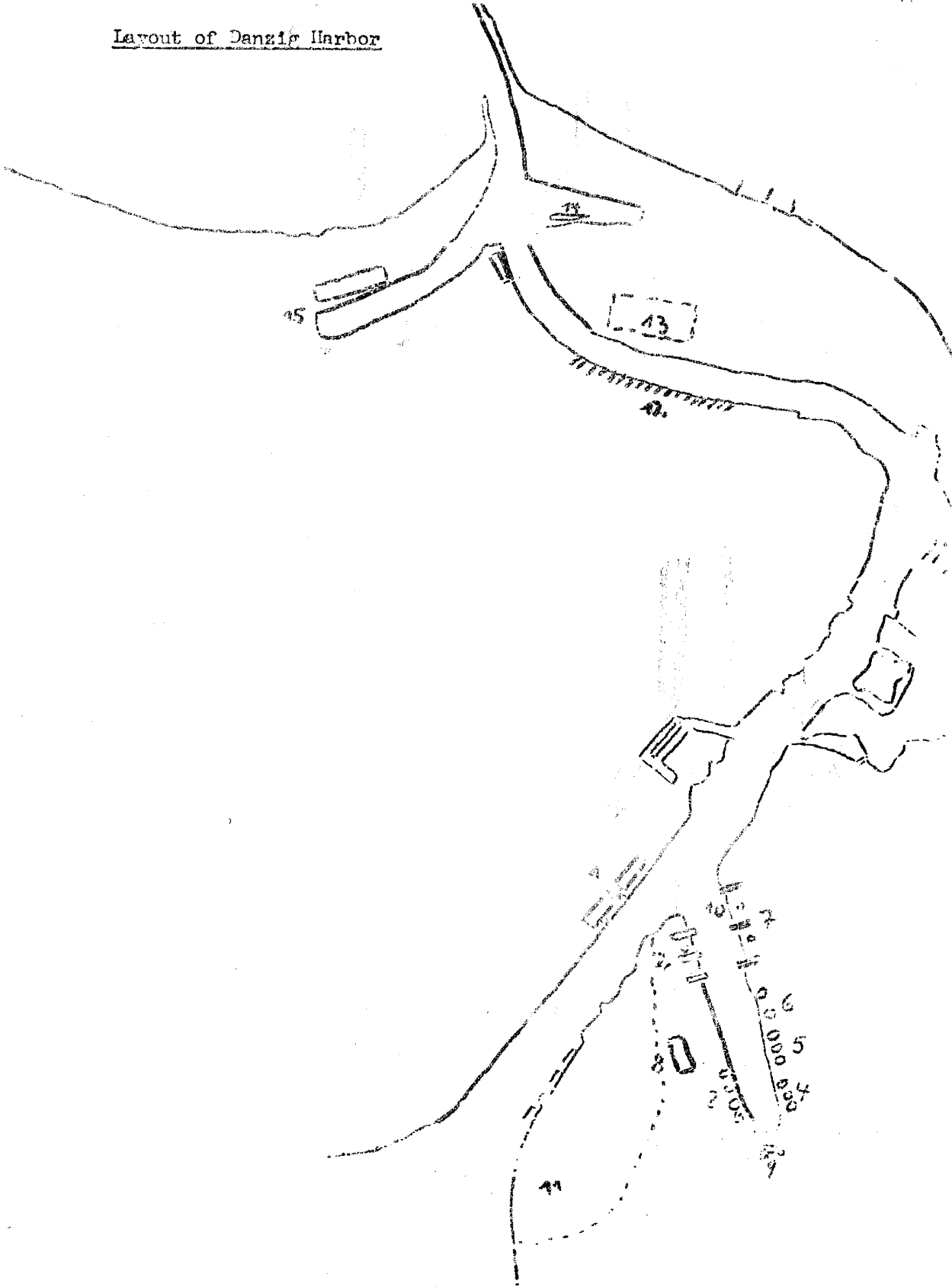

Legend to Annex

- 1 Two large, new Rotterdam-type warehouses. The northern warehouse is being lengthened. On either side of the warehouses are railroad tracks. On the waterfront are two large, new cranes. The cranes are so high that they can load the largest ships.
- 2 Coal Harbor of Weichselmuede (Basen Gorniczny)
- 3 Four new 7-ton luffing cranes installed in late 1949
- 4 Three 7-ton luffing cranes
- 5 Three old cranes, each of 5-ton lifting power.
- 6 One 5-ton crane and one 7-ton crane
- 7 Three coal elevators, each with a capacity of up to 5,000 tons per day
- 8 WOP Barracks. [redacted] 100 Polish naval and WOP personnel billeted there.
- 9 Harbor administration with the only telephone facilities in the port.
- 10 Building site between two coal elevators. The quay foundation has been dug out here.
- 11 Dump and loading station for pit props. The stocks available on 20 March 1950 were estimated at 40,000 to 50,000 cubic meters. No cranes are available.
- 12 New construction of quay and straightening of the fairway in Neufahrwasser (Nowy Port)
- 13 Presumably a rifle range
- 14 Wreck of the former Italian steamer Africana
 All harbor installations in this basin have been destroyed. No loading operations are going on there.
- 15 Large warehouse, about 150 meters long, under construction.
