1. At the Kosice (R 49/E 34) airfield, 1,000 x 400 meters, take-offs and landings are possible only in a north-south direction. Call signal of the airfield is Magda. At present the field is a commercial installation. * Six Czechoslovakian sport planes, two Messerschmitt planes and one unidentified observation plane are stationed at the field, which was guarded by 12 SSB personnel and 40 soldiers. ** The field is to be expanded in 1950 to provide landing facilities for 60 military planes. ***
2. A new airfield about three times the size of the Kosice field is scheduled for construction northeast of Kosice in the valley of the Ondavy River. ***
