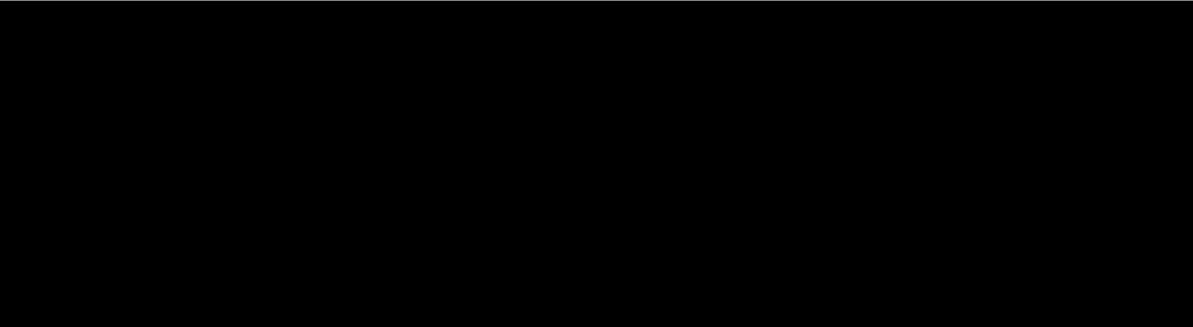

1. There are fifty-two different army units (Poddeleniya) presently located along the valley of the Maritsa River, between the town of Rakovski and the town of Svilengrad.
2. Trains carrying equipment and guarded by groups of four to five soldiers move in the said area every night.
3. Units of the Haskovo artillery regiment are camping near the village of Shiroko-Pole (Kerdzhali-Momchilgrad).
