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SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

The Chinese Communist Special Commissioner's Office in Macao submitted to the South China Politburo a blacklist containing 45 names of persons such as CHANG Hui-ch'ang*, HUANG Han (黃漢)*, KUNG Jo-chien (龔若堅), YUAN Tai (袁帶), KUO Tse-fan (郭則範), LI Ping-t'ou* (李秉頌), LIANG Tzu-tai*, LIANG Wei-hsiang*, P'AN Jo-chang (潘若璋), and WANG Chin-ling (王金伶). In addition there were 17 names of financiers such as FU Hou-ch'eng (傅厚丞), FU Te-yin (傅德蔭)*, and KAO K'o-ning (高可寧)*.

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* Comment. Probable identifications of the individuals listed are as follows:

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CHANG Hui-ch'ang, a guerrilla leader. See [redacted] 25X1A

FU Te-yin, previously reported as FU Tak-yam, in [redacted].

HUANG Han may be the same as HUANG Han-yuan, a guerrilla leader reported in [redacted].

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KAO K'o-ning, previously reported as KO Ho-ning, in SO-[redacted].

LIANG Tzu-tai has been reported as an anti-Communist guerrilla leader in Chungshan in April 1950. See also [redacted] 25X1A

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LIANG Wei-hsiang, a guerrilla leader. See [redacted]

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YUAN Tai, retired guerrilla leader living in Macao. See [redacted].

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** Comment. The romanization received for this name was LI Ping-show.
