A military train consisting of two engines and about forty railway cars was observed on 3 May 1950 at Haskovo station. The train carried about thirty guns and twenty trucks. Eight or ten of the guns were large caliber tractor-drawn weapons, while the remainder were medium caliber guns. The destination of the trains was reported to be Momchilgrad.
