- Sumarno, the public prosecutor in Medan, has tried and dismissed the cases of Saleh Umar and Jacob Siregar.
- 2. Saleh Umar is chairman of the council of the Partai Komunis Indonesia (PKI) in Sumatra and also is a member of the Republik Indonesia Serikat (RIS) House of Representatives in Djakarta. He was charged with conspiracy against the government and accused of causing a number of disturbances throughout North and Best Sumetra. Since Saleh committed his offenses while out of the RIS Parliament, he did not enjoy any special privilages as a member of that Parliement.
- 3. Jacob Siregar, as commander of the Harimau Liar guerrilla band operating around Gunung Tua, south of Medan, was charged with armed revolt. The Harimau Mar (Wild Tiger Corps) is still active and there are a number of Japanese serving in its ranks. This corps expects to make contact with units of the 'alayan Communist Party, who have infiltrated across the Straits of Malacce into Sumatra. Siregar trained many of the younger Tentera Nasional Indonesia (TWI) officers when they were in the "Sakarelah" during the Japanese occupation. Since they knew him, each time Siregar was captured, he was set free by his former students. In January 1950 he was arrested and has been held until recently.
- Ibrahim bin Hadji Tacob* has just settled in Medan. He is chairman of the Malay Mationalist Party, which has been outlewed by the British. Although Thrahim calls his narty now the Free Malay League, he is in close contact with the Melayan Communicaty Pearty of LEE Scong.
