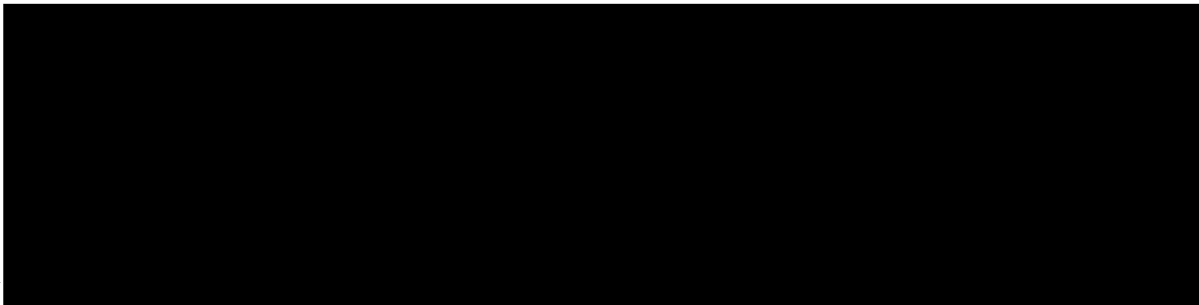

5. Number of machines used in production:

More than 5,000.

6. Sources of materials:

Italy (the principal source), Sweden, Austria, Czechoslovakia, France the United States.

Some of the forging is handled by the Bernardo Cenasio firm, Font Canavese (Turin province), and by Rolle Brothers, Cuorgne (Turin province).

7. Number of laboratories for physical and chemical tests: two.

8. The RIV products are of original design except for the shock absorbers and the Tecalemit (sic). The RIV plants, at the present time, are being renovated. New machinery for technological improvements is being acquired under ERP.

9. The following are being produced in accordance with special aeronautical requirements:

- Ball and roller bearings of various types and sizes;
- Balls, rollers, and small rollers;
- Tappets;
- Segments; and
- Cylinder liners.

At the present time, bearings valued at approximately 4,000,000 lire (sic), are being produced each year by RIV.

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
