- 25X1 1. [redacted] two battalions of the 101 Independent Regiment were at Dopyon-ni.
- 25X1 2. [redacted] elements of the 15 Division with 60 anti-tank guns and mortars and 14 truckloads of supplies were moving to Ipamdong from Uisong (128-42, 36-22).
- 25X1 3. [redacted] one battalion of NKPA troops was at Kodong (128-10, 36-33)\* the 101 Independent Regiment retreated from Kodong.
- [redacted] 4. The commander of the 101 Independent Regiment is Major PYO, a former ROK member who defected to North Korea in 1949. The regiment includes 19 battalions, totaling 15,000 troops from 50,000 men recruited in Seoul and Inchon for the security forces.
- 25X1 5. [redacted] NKPA forces from Taegu to Choyang to Pohang consisted of the 15 Division composed of NKPA regulars and ex-Chinese Communist Army Koreans; the 5 Division composed of ex-Chinese Communist Army Koreans; one division, possibly the 2 Division, composed of NKPA regulars, the 7 Division in the Pohang area, and the 101 Independent Regiment. The first three divisions are above strength; the strength of the 7 Division is unknown.
- 25X1 6. [redacted] 2,000 Volunteer Army troops were in the Chongsong (129-04, 36-26) area.

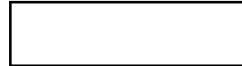
