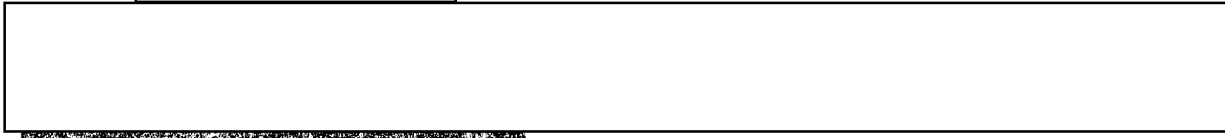

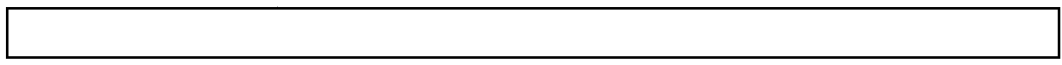

 - 2) Deputy Commanding Officer a major or staff captain
 - 3) 1st Assistant
 - 4) 2nd Assistant

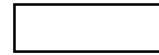

7. Forced labor camps in the Ostrava area are located at Kuncicky, Vitkovice and Trinec. They are supervised by Lt. Col. Jar. Mottl, who is 55 years of age. Prisoners work in the mines and in the ironworks. In October 1949 700 persons were imprisoned in these camps.
