

During the last week of August 1950, the 46,* 47, 48* and 16* Armies of the 4 Field Army entered North Korea from Manchuria.

- 2. A total of 300,000 Chinese Communist troops are stationed at Antung (124-23, 40-09), Linchiang (126-54, 41-42) and Chian (126-10, 41-07).
- 3. It is reported that all passenger rail traffic between Antung and Mukden was suspended during August, and passenger trains on this line are now carrying troops and other military personnel.
- 4. During the first week in September military training institutes in Llukden were evacuated to Tsitsihar. In early September a Llukden Air Defense Corps was created, headed by TUAN Shu-chuan, also assistant chief of staff in Llanchuria.****
- 5. Manchuria is preparing for war.
