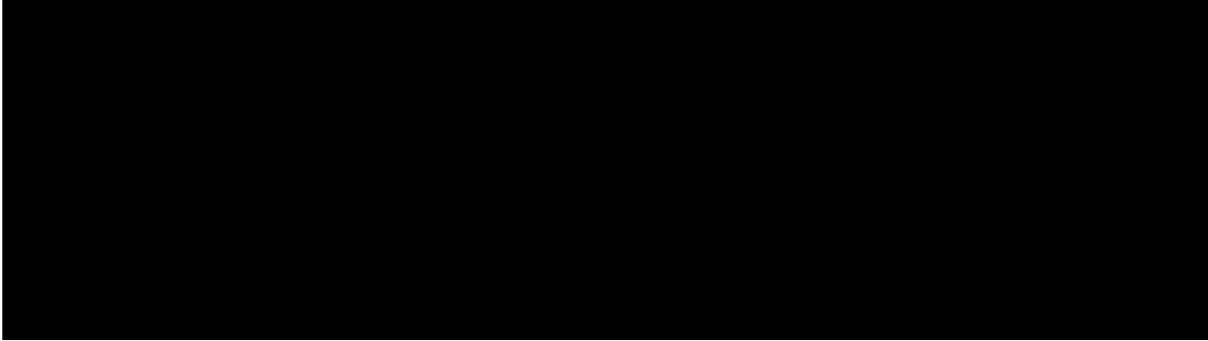

- 25X1X 1. On 23 July 1950 Bulgarian authorities ordered the peasants to get in their crops immediately. [redacted] many of the peasants delayed in fulfilling this order at least to the first week of August [redacted] was not able to observe after this date) because they expected United States' military action in the Balkans sometime this summer. 25X1X
- 25X1X 2. [redacted] Bulgarians are ripe for action against the Communists, and their only need is for the United States to supply them with arms. 25X1X [redacted] at least 95 percent of the people are waiting "Der Tag" to start liquidating the Communists.
- 25X1X 3. The strongest political leaders in Bulgaria today are Stoycho Moushanov and Dimitar Gichev. [redacted] in a free election the right wing Agrarians and the Democrats (Gichevists and Moushanovists) would easily carry the country. Very little is heard of Dr. Georgi M. Dimitrov who has little backing except for the small backing given by the Pladnari (left wing Agrarians, the party of G.M. Dimitrov).
- 25X1X 4. [redacted] Gichev has been badly beaten, worked, and starved. Reportedly Gichev is in poor physical condition and has been taken to an unknown spot in the country to recuperate.
- 5. Nikola Moushanov, who is now 80 years old, is in bad health. Moushanov had been at Camp Belene, near Svishtov, in 1949. Because of failing health he was allowed to go to live with Doncho Smilov, a former minister in the cabinet in 1931-33, who lives in Veliko Turnovo. Stoycho Moushanov, who is 50-55 years old, is in good physical condition.
- 25X1X 6. [redacted] each Bulgarian town and village now has what is known as an "Active Comitet" made up of about five to seven trusted Communists. The duty of this group will be to kill all opposition leaders in the event of an uprising, emergency, or war. Each member of these "goon squads" has a list of names, [redacted] Furthermore, the [redacted] that each Communist is so afraid that he does favors for at least one person in the opposition as a safety factor should the present Communist regime fall. 25X1X
