- Two Soviet troop trains arrived in Kuestran (0 53/V 66) on 8 august 1950 and one train on 19 August 1950, coming from Tagdeburg or Altengrabow. Mach train was so mosed of flatears carrying about 30 trucks an six 76.2-m in juns, and six boxcars each occupied by about 30 officers and soldiers. The units were unloaded and moved to the artilleric Lasern , Kuestrin-Altstadt which had been completely restored and enlarged.
- 2. On 2 September 1950 about 300 Soviet troops, most of whom wore artillery insignia, were stationed in Kuestrin. I large percentage of the personnel wore war decorations. *
