1. Two Soviet troop trains arrived in Kuestrin (O 53/V 66) on 8 August 1950 and one train on 19 August 1950, coming from Magdeburg or Altengrabow. Each train was composed of flatcars carrying about 30 trucks and six 76.2-mm AA guns, and six boxcars each occupied by about 30 officers and soldiers. The units were unloaded and moved to the Artillerie Kasern, Kuestrin-Altstadt which had been completely restored and enlarged.
2. On 2 September 1950 about 300 Soviet troops, most of whom wore artillery insignia, were stationed in Kuestrin. A large percentage of the personnel wore war decorations. \*
