On 29 August 1930 the Withstock (N 51/0 11 ) sinfield was occupied by two twin-engine planes, four single-engine fighters, and four eiplanes. 25X1A 2. An unidentified general was attached to the general staff at the field. Lieutenant Colonel (Eng) Krimski (fnu), about 50 years old, was subordinate to the ceneral staff. Recently he often stayed in Frenzlau (N 5h/2 0h) to examine military installations, an rotedam (N 53/% 63) for conferences or reports, and in Furrstenborg/Medilanburg (N 5h/9 52) for undetermined purposes. (2) 3. Construction work on the new runway was completed by 15 /ugust 1950 and all workers of the Bauunion-North Firm which had the contract for the work were dismissed or transferred. (3) A Soviet officer said that the runway was 2,000 meters long. (a) On the eastern and western ends of the runway the construction of perpendicular landing strips was still in progress. Since there has been no accumulation of water on the field there is probably a drainage system. Lights on poles about 50 cm high and 100 meters apart were being et up along the rankay. There were two lamps, about a meter apart on the top of each pole. The lamps, which beamed red light, were in operation at night. Cimilar lamps, but with white light, were on both sides of the baxiways. (5) 25X1C 5. Conversations among officers at the field indicated that use on the runway was to start on 1 Contember 1950. 6. A detail of 50 WP men was still stationed at the field.
