SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- Since the Chinese Communist occupation of Hainan Island in May 1950, FERG Pai-chi\* (特句 期), deputy chief of the Chinese Communist Hilitary and Political Committee in Hainan, has reorganized the 10,000 local Communist troops into three divisions of seven regiments and an independent regiment. WU K'e-chih\*\* (美元之) is commander of the First Division, which is stationed in Haikou (110-20, 20-03) and Chiungshan (110-21, 20-02). CHANG K'ai-tai\*\* (沃高) is commander of the Second Division, which is stationed in Yulin (109-34, 18-13). CH'EN Wu-sheng\*\* (京京文) is commander of the Third Division, which is stationed in Chiachi (110-24, 19-20) and Wenchang (110-42, 19-42).
- 2. In late May when TENG Hua\*\*\* transferred from Hainan to Canton, HSIAO Huanhui replaced him as Chief of the Chinese Communist Military and Political Committee in Hainan.
- 3. The Chinese Communist Party has appointed one or more military representatives to all district governments and middle schools in Hainan to supervise their activities.

- Comment. According to the press, FENG Pai-chi's forces are planning on invading the Paracel Islands in coordination with the Vietminh offensive. FERC was reported as one of a committee of three persons responsible for fortifying Yulin harbor by October 1950.
- Comment. WU K's chih previously served as commissar of the Chinese 35-35 Communist guerrilla organization in Hainan. CHANG K'ai-tai is probably the CHANG Kuo-t'ai reported as commander of the 4th Division of this organization. CH'EN Thu-sheng was commander of the 5th Division of this organization (See SU-38239)
- Comment. In early June TENG Hua attended a conference in Centon regarding the movement of Chinese Communist troops to French Indochina 25X1A
