- Between 25 and 30 September 1950, the following Chinese Communist warships arrived at Mansharwei (112-53, 24-16): the KUOKAM (東東), 385 tons; the FINTCU (富門), 80 tons; and the MARVII (海岸).
- On 29 September, the Chinese Communists set up a patrol command post at Tungao (113-, 22-). From 29 September to 2 October, one to three small Chinese Communist warships patrolled Tungao nightly.*
- In late September two 15 millimeter cannons (sic) were emplaced on a hilltop 3。 on Tungao.
- On 3 October, the SS CHECKP'ING (建平) left Canton for Chiangmen (113-06, 4. 22-34) with 20 bazookas and 35 light machine guns aboard. These weapons were to be sent immediately to Haadquarters 1 Battalion, 21 Regiment, in Shuinanhsiang (水南鄉), northwest of Chiangmen.
- On 6 October, the Chinese Communist gunboats CHIEHFANG (解放) Number 1 and Number 2, formerly stationed at Wantzu (灣分) in the Chingshan area, sailed to Nansharwei (112-53, 24-16).**
- On 6 October, 130 anti-aircraft personnel, with 6 Soviet-made anti-aircraft guns, were sent to the Wanshan (113-, 22-) Islands from Yink'eng (ik, in) and Maliushan (ik, in), southwest of Macao, on the small Chinese Communist 6。 gunboat Number 52.***
