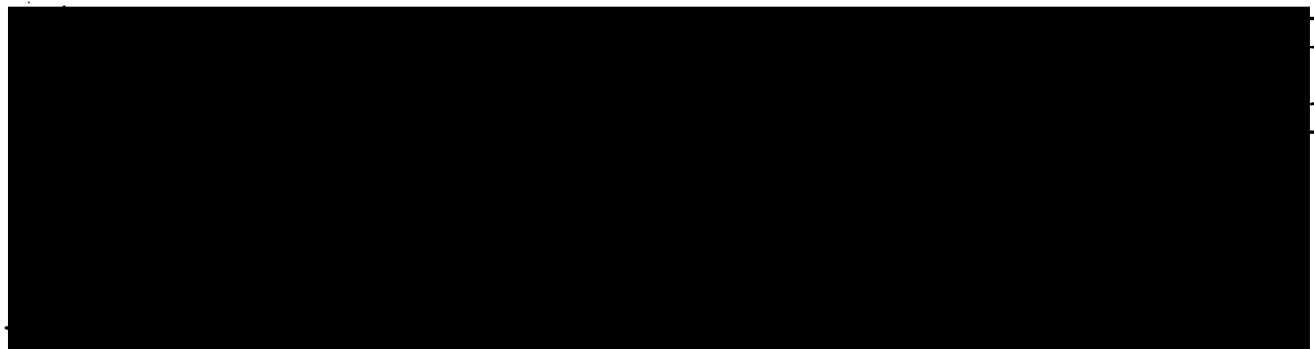

1. On 15 July 1950, CHUNG I-~~chung~~ (鍾亦光), of the Chinese Communist Air Force in Canton, received instructions to take 12 air personnel with him to Hankow immediately. Following this, they disassembled 3 YAK-21 aircraft and packed them for transport to Hankow.\*
2. T'ANG I-hsin (唐逸新), of the 2 Company, 3 Repair and Protection Battalion,\*\* will go to Huiyang (111-26, 11-05) from Fuzhou (白沙) with his unit, he will be accompanied by Ke-la-shi (柯拉希) a Soviet engineer, and Ho-to-pa-fu (赫吐巴夫),\*\*\* a Soviet advisor. They will survey the Achupa (澳沙巴) Airfield in Huiyang, preparatory to its conversion into a supply sub-station.
