REMARKS _____

1. All military quarters in Korneuburg (P 49/S 30) were occupied on 13 September 1950. Four light AA guns were seen in the yard of the Albrechts Kaserne and trucks _____ in front of the installation. Rations were unloaded _____ in front of the officers' mess opposite the railroad station. Passenger car _____ was seen parking in front of the office on Hovengasse and later leaving, occupied by a colonel. Two light AA guns and truck _____ were observed at the armory on Wienerstrasse, at the corner of Kwitzgasse. Eleven trucks and one jeep were in the garage at 8-10 Hovengasse. Twenty heavy AA guns were stored in sheds and 20 light AA guns and 3 AA machine guns were seen outdoors in the cantonment on the road to Bisamberg (P 49/S 30). Troops with blue service color were seen in the installation formerly occupied by the Imperial and Royal Austrian Railway Regt. Truck _____ entered the installation. *50X1-HUM
