- 1. Local residents said that Soviet troops did not arrive at or leave the Templin (N 54/U 01) maneuver area during the two weeks prior to 6 September 1950. No large number of troops were seen marching or training. Intensive traffic of supply trucks was observed at Harnelspring and Vogelsang. [redacted]
