1. An ambulance and 18 trucks [redacted] were observed moving toward Seeburg from the direction of Glienicke on 24 August 1950. Some of the trucks towed artillery pieces. (1)

2. A train carrying about 100 soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, and riding in four boxcars, four AA guns of about 80 mm caliber, eight trucks and one passenger car, [redacted] passed through Wittenberge on 27 August 1950. The train came from the direction of Schwerin and proceeded toward Stendal. (2)

3. Motor vehicles [redacted] were seen driving toward Ludwigslust on 6 September 1950. They had come from the direction of Schwerin. Each vehicle carried about 20 soldiers who wore red-bordered black epaulets. (3)

4. A train without an engine stood at the Luebben freight station on 12 September 1950. It carried 16 trucks [redacted] About 100 soldiers stood on the platform with folded blanket around their shoulders. (4)

5. Daily Soviet leave traffic through Frankfurt/Oder between 9 and 17 September 1950 averaged 380 soldiers going to Brest Litovsk and 620 soldiers coming from there. (5) Twelve tanks were detrained over the military camp at Frankfurt/Oder during the night of 13 September 1950. Six tanks from Lieberose were detrained the afternoon of 14 September 1950. Nine tanks were dispatched to Eberswalde. (6) No military shipments from Brest Litovsk passed through Frankfurt/Oder during the period beginning 9 September and ending at 8 p.m. on 17 September 1950.

(2) Presumably a unit of the unidentified AAA Div of the Third Gds Mecz Army, which returned to its post from the Wustrow AAA range.

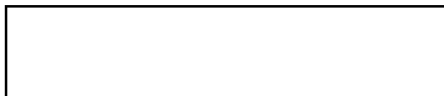
25X1A (3) an element of the 94th Gds Mtz Rifle Div.
