1. Twenty-six locomotives, all of them heavily damaged, were turned over to Poland in Fuerstenwalde (N 53/V 33) on 1 August 1950. 25X1

2. From 12 to 15 locomotives which had been parked at the Frankfurt/Oder (O 53/V 63) railroad station were dispatched in the direction of Poland on 5 August 1950 after having been marked with the Polish insignia. ** 25X1A

25X1A * [redacted] Comment. Probably those locomotives of the foreign locomotive park which had been made movable. Their assembly in Fuerstenwalde was previously reported in [redacted]. The number of such foreign-owned locomotives remaining in the Soviet Zone of Germany because of heavy war damage totaled 1,117 units on 30 June 1950. 25X1A

** [redacted] Comment. Probably some of the locomotives now being returned to their home countries.
