THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. The Nan Fang (Southern) Trading Company, Macao, is controlled by both the Canton Military Control Commission and Canton merchants, and is thus a mixture of state-sponsored and private enterprise. In early August 1950 it was managed by K'0 P'ing\*, brother of Dr. K'0 Lin. At that time it owned two landing craft of about 700 tons each.
2. On 13 September 1950 CHANG Chih-i (張執一), chief of the United Front Work Department of the South China Sub-Bureau\*\*, visited Macao. He left Macao for Hong Kong that night, and on 14 September visited the Hong Kong office of the China Merchants' Steam Navigation Company.
