

- the United Front Department of the Kwangsi Provincial Party Committee, the Political Security Department of the Kwangsi Military District and the secretariat of the Kwangsi Provincial Government concerning the exchange of information and the excediting of supplies and arms shipments. The station is headed by "U Yi (武義), a native of Saigon, with WU Ping (五字) and KUMN Hsing-chich (廣星管)* as his subordinates.
- On 1 September a Viet Minh Army Military Training School at Lungchou (106-56, 22-22) graduated its first class of 430 officers trained in artillery, engineering and air defense, who returned to Indochina on 7 September.
- In mid-September, 300 tons of mifle ammunition and hand gronades arrived in Liuchou, Kwangsi, by the Human-Kwangsi railroad, and were shipped by truck to the Supply and Service Command of the Kwangsi Hilitary District at Manning. Part was ammunition of the 65 type.
- On 15 October Chinese Communist troops in Kwangsi totaled 180,000, including one army in the Kweilin-Liuchou area, another in the Hanning area and a trird along the Yu and Hsun Pivers. One army of the 2 Field Army under CHEN Keng was guarding the Kwangsi-Yunnan border. One division of the Railroad Army Group was guarding the railroad between Kweilin and Laipin. Fourteen independent regiments and 105 detachments of local troops were under the Kwangsi Military District.
