On eight groups, four of VP personnel and four of Soviet soldiers, were seen together in the training area northweat of Neustrelitz (N 5h/U 5h), where they were engaged in training with three T-3h tanks. At first the police and the soldiers assembled around one tank which a Soviet officer used for instruction purposes. Individual soldiers or policemen occasionally had to climb into the turret.


2. The three training tanks, each flanked by one Jerman and one Soviet group, were later seen moving toward the wooded area. The VP personnel were new style uniforms. \*
