- On 11 July 1950, the Yugoslav Ministry of the Interior decreed the establishment of a restricted area, 15 km wide, along the entire Yugoslav border. Inhabitants of this area will be furnished with special identity cards while transients will be required to produce special permits issued by the police authorities. The issuance of such permits to Yugoslav nationals or to foreigners is regulated by specific directives which have been given to local administrative agencies (okrani odbor).
