

- 4 Newly built workshops, steel and brick structures a Large hall in which two tanks 12 meters long and 4 meters in diameter were set up on a scaffolding 1 meter high b and c Five rooms of equal size, 5 meters wide

 - b Twenty-four steel cylinders were installed in this room in late 1948. They were 3 meters long and 50 cm in diameter and were stored in groups of four on frames. The cylinders were so heavy that they had to be lifted by three sets of pullies.
 - c Soviet engineers stated that workshops were to be installed there.
 - The remainder of the building was not yet equipped.
