On 20 September 1950 it was learned that the 5th VP Bereitschaft of Land Thuringia in Weissenfels (11 52/J 99) has been brought up to a strength of more than 2,000 police since the end of August 1950. It was said that more quarters were being prepared to house the unit's personnel. New olive drab VP uniforms were being taken to the quartermaster supply rooms to be stocked there. 2. The 10th VP Bereitschaft of Land Thuringia, an infantry unit, was located in the former Spinnhuette (spinning mill), Apolda. The Pereitschaft had about 1,500 police and was commanded by VP Oberrat alter, (fnu). VP Derkommissar Kressmann, (fnu), was identified as the unit's supply officer. \* 25X1A Comment. The 5th VP Bereitschaft (Inf) of Land Saxony-Anhalt (not of Land Thuringia) in the former rtilleric Kaserne of "eissenfels and the 10th VP Bereitschaft (Inf) of Land Thuringia in the Spinnhuette of Apolda wore repeatedly confirmed prior to August 1950. See The strength of the two units is considered 25X1A too nigh even if the reassignment of VP school graduates may have resulted in a slight increase of the units which have been so far estimated at 900 to 1,000 police each.
