The Perlin representative of the Synthese SAG in Schwarzheide (N 52/A 23), a certain Brotkorb, (fnu), was ordered by his firm to move from his residence at 61 Fuerst Hohenlohestrasse in Lichtenberg to a building in Zehlendorf in the Western Sector of Berlin. The alleged reason for this extraordinary measure was that intensified trade relations with the Hoechst Farben Plant since 1 July 1950 made it expedient to have the residence of a German SAG representative in the Western Sector of Berlin.
