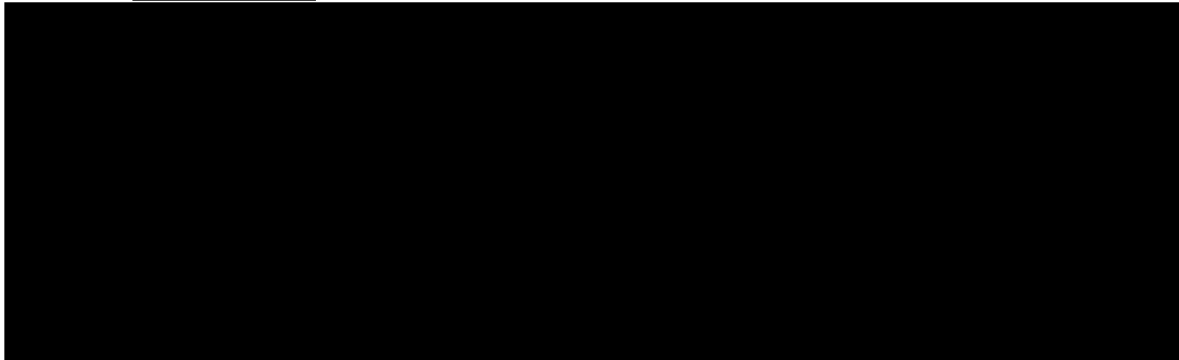

Members of the FDJ employed in government offices, who participated in the FDJ rally in Berlin, at Whitsuntide 1950, are now being rewarded for their loyalty by preferential promotions, salary increases, and similar favors. The effect of this is two-fold:

1. It will induce other young people who might previously have been what in the Soviet Zone known as "politically indifferent" to take part in the local political activity, and will undoubtedly encourage greater participation in future rallies and other affairs similar to the one in Berlin.
2. It promotes otherwise not necessarily capable or eligible persons out of turn, over the heads of others, and thus weakens morale and efficiency in the offices concerned.
