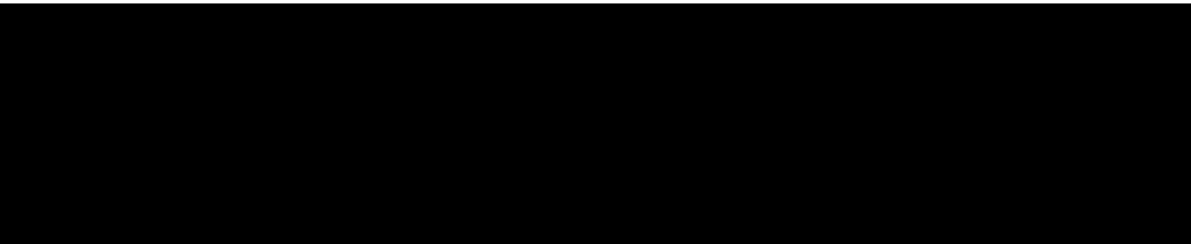

1. No flying was done by units of the 24th Air Army in the Soviet Zone of Germany on Sunday, 5 November 1950, or during the celebrations of the anniversary of the October Revolution, 6-8 November. The only units observed were the following:

Fighter division headquarter at Peenemünde and a fighter regiment at Neubrandenburg, on 5 November and again on 7 November.

2. The following units were observed on 9 November:

Fighter division headquarters at Peenemünde.

Fighter regiments at Alt-Lönnowitz and Neubrandenburg.
