In mid-October about 3,000 troops of the 1 Battalion of FENG Pai-chu's Hainan Column in Hainan moved to positions near Tunghsing (107-58, 21-33). The battalion is equipped with captured Nationalist arms and its combat strength is comparable to the regular 4 Field Army units. The battalion has some Japanese, Korean, and Taiwanese personnel and is commanded by WU K'o-chih (吳克之), deputy commander of the Hainan Column.
