1. The aluminum plant in Stalinsk (57°07'N/53°46'E), Kemerovo Oblast, was composed of an old section measuring about 1,000 x 300 meters and a new section of about the same size under construction. *
2. The new section was separated from the old plant by a railroad line. On the site of the new section four foundations 100 x 40 meters each were being dug out and another site was being leveled.
3. About 1,000 Soviets and 1,000 PT's, the latter doing excavating and hauling, were employed at the plant. Construction work was done in one shift, while three productive shifts were worked in the plant. ** The construction work was supervised by Soviets. The employment of German engineers was not known.
4. Raw materials arrived by rail. An undetermined number of aluminum bars were produced and shipped to Stalinsk. ***

* [REDACTED] Comment. The location of the aluminum plant was previously reported. The reported layout of the plant essentially agrees with previous information. The new section allegedly under construction is reported for the first time. For layout sketch of plant see Annex.

*** [REDACTED] Comment. To date the 1950 output of the aluminum plant has been believed to be 15,000 tons. An increase of this output would be possible only by an essential increase of the capacity of the neighboring power plant. Since the power plant is actually being enlarged the statement on an enlargement of the aluminum plant appears to be correct. [REDACTED] 25X1A
