- 1. After long discussion, Taiwan\* has appointed four guerrilla leaders in the Pearl River, East River, West River and North River areas. The only known appointee is CH'EN P'ei ( ), former commander of the Kwangtung provincial forces and a native of Maoming (110-53, 21-45), as commander in southwest Kwangtung. All guerrilla leaders are Taiwan-trained and are to be responsible for helen administration in the event of a Nationalist offensive on the mainland. \*\*
- CH'EN Chi-tang has been tentatively chosen by the Generalissimo as administrative head of Kwangtung.
- 3. KUO Ying-shu states that Taiwan\* has commissioned him as director of the resistance movement. KUO has already sent agents to Canton to spread rumors of a Nationalist offensive in order to raise popular morale and scare Communist officials.

25X1A Comment. for the appointment of Kwangtung guerrilla leaders by the various Taiwan factions contending for control of mainland guerrillas.

Comment. states that the Ministry of National Defense is organizing 15 training groups of personnel to be used in military government when the Nationalistereturn to the mainland.
