Schwerin

- 1. During the night of 17 October 1950 troops on trucks moved into the Fritsch Kaserne, Schwerin (M 54/T 46). About 100 motor vehicles, each carrying about 10 soldiers, were observed. [redacted] Some of the trucks towed artillery pieces. *
- 2. On 19 October 1950 troops with about 50 trucks towing artillery pieces moved into the Adolf Hitler Kaserne, Schwerin. *
- 3. On 19 October 1950 the Fritsch Kaserne, the Krueger Kaserne, the Moltke Kaserne, and the Adolf Hitler Kaserne seemed to be occupied to capacity by troops. *

Letzling Heath

- 4. On 26 October 1950 no troops were observed in the forest camp at Letzling Heath (M 53/Y 53). No incoming and outgoing rail shipments were seen that day. **

* [redacted] Comment. The elements of the 94th Gds Mtz Rifle Div from Schwerin returned to their posts by 19 October 1950, after the fall maneuvers of the Third Shock Army in the Magdeburg-Dessau area.

** [redacted] Comment. The elements of the 19th Gds Mecz Div which had remained at Letzling Heath and/or which had returned to Letzling Heath after field exercises in mid-October 1950 had left for their home stations by 26 October 1950.
