25X1A	(1)	Comments.  The information on the Delius Kaserne concerns the 30th Gds Gun Arty Brig of the unidentified artillery division in Potsdam which is stationed there. Following the return of artillery units to the installation from the Altengrabow training area prior to 17 October 1950, additional artillery units returned to the 25X1A billeting area on 19 October 1950.  Elements of the artillery division from Potsdam participated in fall maneuvers in the Magdeburg-Wittenberg area during the first half of October 1950. Present report indicates that recruits and officer replacements also arrived in the Delius Kaserne. The 21 officers who left the installation on 18 October 1950 possibly returned to the			
	(3)	U.S.S.R. for demobilization.  To date no Soviet troops have been observed in Schwedt on the Oder River. Further information is required to clarify whether or not a Soviet unit was activated there.  On 9 October 1950, the elements of the 10th Gds Tank Div from the Kavallerie 25X1A Schule held field exercises in the Ketzin area. Present report indicates that the units returned to the installation by 19 October 1950.  Ceneral Loshkin (fnu) has been carried since 147 as chief of the Gas and Oil Distribution Department of the GOFG on Pappelallee, Fotsdam, and was last con-
