


- A rumor circulating in Macao, said to have been started in Canton, is that the Chinese Communist Revoluti nary Military Council has decided to make a surprise attack on Hong Kong at the beginning of spring 1951.\* The Council plans to use three divisions of the Ewangtung-Ewangsi Column as front line units and ten divisions of the 3 Field Arry. In addition men and arms will be moved clandestinely to Hong Kong, and the underground armed forces there will be expanded for action to cordinate with the military attack.
- At the same time the rumor is that the Chinese will initiate formal diplomatic negotiations with the Macao Government to culminate in military control of the Colony carried out by one division of the Kwangt ng-Kwangsi Column.\*\*

25X1A Comment. According to the Chinese calendar, spring begins on February this year.

Commont. Military control in this case probably means military 25X1A occupation with the civil administration unchanged.
