REMARKS

1. The Zwoelfaxing (P 49/X 48) airfield was occupied by 36 Pe-2s and about 4 to 6 fighters on 5 October 1950. There was no flying between 8 a.m. and noon.
2. The Pe-2s were parked in three rows of 12 planes each, and the fighters in one row.
3. One twin-engine plane with single rudder assembly and 36 Pe-2s, were counted at the field on 14 November. The twin-engine plane was silver and in appearance was similar to those aircraft which are permanently seen in Wiener Neustadt.
4. About 20 to 30 soldiers wearing fatigue uniforms stood around a Pe-2 on which instruction was being given.
5. Motor vehicles [redacted] were seen. 50X1-HUM
6. There were 36 Pe-2s in three rows of 12 planes each counted at the field on 7 December 1950.
7. There was no flying activity, and almost no other activity, between 8:30 a.m. and noon. Some of the aircraft were covered with tarpaulins.
8. No construction work was in progress at the field. No changes were observed. *
9. Trucks [redacted] entered and left the field. **

Comment. This observation is significant because of a rumor that jet aircraft were seen in the Vienna area.

Comment. The report indicates that the occupation of the Zwoelfaxing airfield has not changed as compared with the observations made in the summer months of 1950. The field is still occupied by one bomber regiment, probably the 80th Gds Bmr Regt of the 1st Gds Bmr Div. 50X1-HUM

[redacted] the ground units at the field have not changed.
