1. The Chinese Communist leaders are fully agreed on the military pact concluded between them and the Soviets in March 1950. There is no split on this issue. The Party intends to complete the occupation of Korea, even at the risk of a world war. The Party also plans an invasion of Taiwan in March or April 1951.
2. From 31 December to 2 January representatives of all government organs, schools, factories, and unions in Canton participated in anti-American and aid-Korea parades, carrying placards with slogans saying, "Liberate All Korea. Liberate Taiwan. Liberate Hong Kong and Macao."
3. By 1 January two-thirds of the staffs of all military and civil offices still in Canton had moved to suburban areas ten miles outside of the city, to reduce losses from possible air raids.**
