

7. On 25 November 1950, the Infanterie Kaserne, or Douaumont Kaserne, still seemed to be only partly occupied. About 40 percent of the barracks windows were lighted that night. Trucks, whose numbers could not be determined, were seen through the doors of the first garage on Penzlinerstrasse, just north of the billeting area, on 17 November. (2)

8. Between 17 and 25 November, only little activity by military personnel was observed in the Adolf Hitler Kaserne on Strelitzer-strasse in the daytime. Not more than 40 percent of the barracks windows were lighted in the evenings. No motor traffic was noted. About 30 officers with black service color were observed at the railroad station at about 9 p.m. on 21 November. (4)
