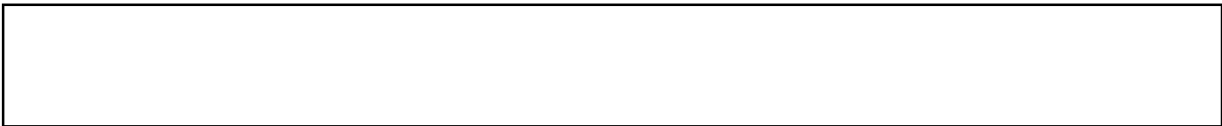

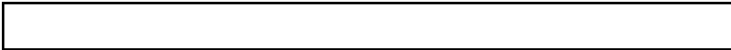

 - b. Wu-la-ssu-k'o (烏拉司克)* to Tihua via Alma Ata and Ining (81-17, 43-55).
2. The supply depot of the 7 Division, 3 Army, is at Kaot'ai (99-58, 39-21).
