1. The South China Sub-Bureau has ordered the Chungshan (113-36, 22-22) hsien Military Control Commission* to assume responsibility for:
 - a. Control of exports to Macao and Hong Kong.
 - b. Registration of all Chinese with knowledge of Japan and the Japanese language, whether they are presently local residents or residents of Japan.
 - c. The establishment of a Japanese political training center.
2. Upon receipt of the above orders the Chungshan Military Control Commission issued a circular to the Farmers' Unions asking for their cooperation in implementing the program.
3. With the assistance of the Sino-Soviet Friendship Association a Japanese political training center has been established in Chungshan which is scheduled to open on 5 January 1951.
