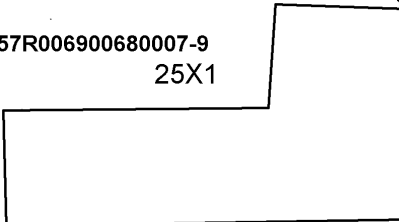

[redacted] flatcars have been pooled in Frankfurt/Oder and dispatched empty toward Brest-Litovsk at the rate of one train per day."

2. It has been confirmed that tanks, motor vehicles, and personnel of the Seventh Guards Mechanized Division were loaded on trains in Frankfurt/Oder [redacted] All of the trains loaded departed toward Lieberose. The first of the trains to leave returned to Frankfurt/Oder from Lieberose [redacted]

3. An AAA unit from the Artillerie Kaserne, Frankfurt/Oder departed by road in the direction of Lieberose [redacted] 25X1

4. A train of about 60 boxcars, carrying troops, arrived in Frankfurt/Oder from the east [redacted] The soldiers were between 18 and 20 years of age and wore red-bordered black epaulets. The train may have continued westward, beyond Frankfurt/Oder.
