- Chinese Communist military authorities at Wanch'ingsha (萬頃沙), Tungkuan (113-46, 23-02) Hsien in late January ordered all women's associations to urge their husbands and sons between 18 and 28 years of age to join the army as volunteers for Korea. Each volunteer is to receive the title of hero and a souvenir photograph of his family.
- The authorities of Tungkuan and Chungshan (113-36, 22-22) Hsien were impressing labor for military construction in late January. Village heads and farmers associations were ordered to conscript one person from each house to dig trenches along the sea coast and rivers. For each of the laborers there must be furnished three catties of rice daily for food, and the laborers receive no pay.
- On 18 January over 100 inmates of the jail at Hsinhsing (112-12, 22-48), mostly former Nationalist local soldiers, revolted because of bad treatment and killed five wardens. About 20 inmates were killed trying to escape, but the rest got away.
- On 18 January Chungshan Hsien authorities demanded of the Macao Government that all Nationalist officials be driven from Macao, that Communist soldiers be permitted to enter Macao to arrest Nationalist and guerrilla suspects, and that there be established an office of the Chungshan Military Affairs Committee in Macao. The Governor of Macao refused all these demands.
