SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. A chemical factory is located in Bohumin. It employs about 200 persons; 50 of them are chemists who are between 35 and 40 years old and who live in the factory. Rudolf Pluskal, a Czech between 55 and 60 years of age, is the manager of this chemical factory, and he is also commander of the workshop militia and chairman of the workers' council. He is an ardent and dangerous Communist. From 1915 to 1936 he lived in the USSR, where he worked as a factory manager. During the war he lived in Germany, and he came to Bohumin with the Red Army. He became the leading functionary in this chemical factory immediately after his arrival.
2. Production at the chemical factory consists of the following:
 - a. Acids
 - b. Zinc white
 - c. Various physics
 - d. Poisons
 - e. Special gases
 - f. Fuel for V-2
 - g. Saccharine
3. These products are transported in covered cars labeled "explosives, poisons" in Czech, Russian and Polish. These labels are numbered only and do not indicate destination.
4. The factory is guarded by a works militia of about 15 men and possibly also by the STB.
5. The United Chemical Works, formerly Larisch-Moenich, is located in Petrovice near Bohumin. Its manager is Ing. Matejovsky, who is about 40 years old and a Communist under compulsion.

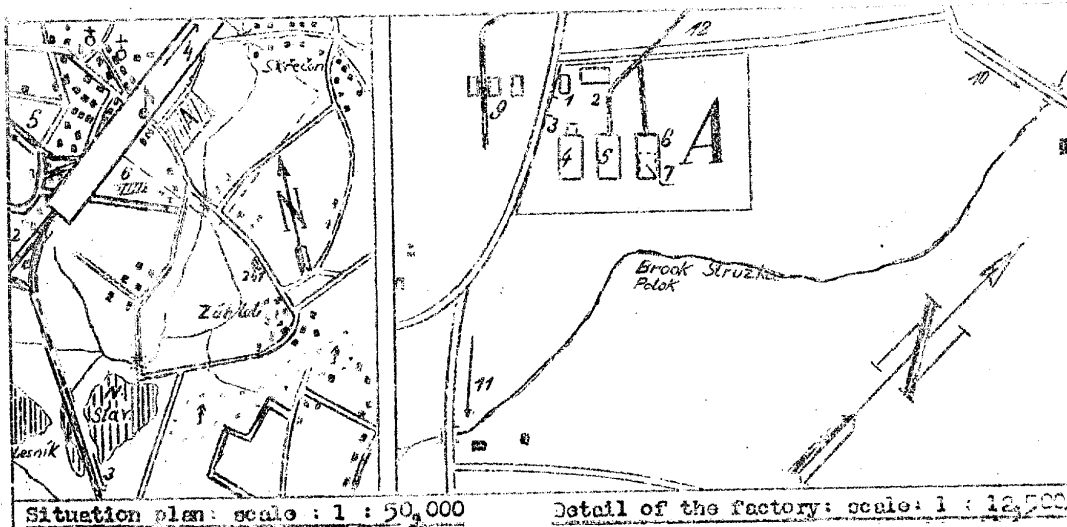

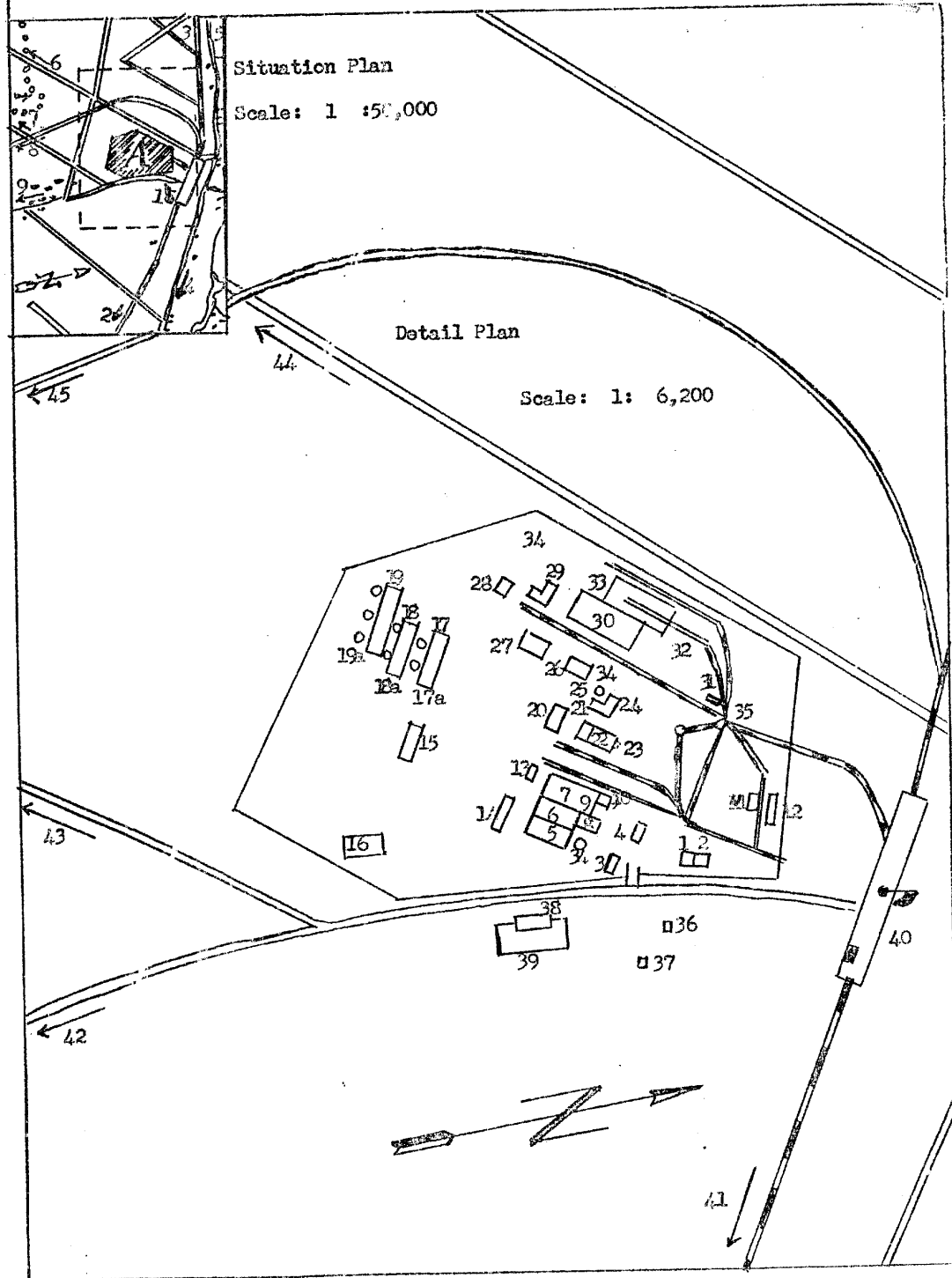
