1. Indications are that in accordance with the wishes of Mohamed ben Youssef el Alaoui, Sultan of Morocco, the new Resident General of Morocco, if and when General Alphonse Juin is relieved, will not be a military man.
2. As a replacement for General Juin, the French Government is considering Paul Devinat, Radical Socialist deputy to the French Assembly, or Marcel Edmond Naegelen, present Governor General of Algeria. If the latter should be selected, Berthouin (fnu), "Rapporteur General du Budget" in the French Senate, would go to Algeria as Governor General. [REDACTED] candidates with lesser chances are Leon Pignon, former Governor General of Indo-China, and Paul Ramadier, former Premier and now Socialist deputy to the National Assembly.
