1. At 6:55 p.m. on 19 February 1951, the Berlin Reichsbahndirektion sent the following teletyped order to all railroad offices:
 - a. "Effective immediately, no R, X, and S type railroad cars capable of transit operations will be loaded.
 - b. All R, X, and S type cars will be inspected for their capacity for transit operations.
 - c. If sufficient R, X, and S cars are not available, a corresponding number of gondola cars will be made available.
 - d. All cars capable of transit operations will be reported via telephone extension 23143 and dispatched to Frankfurt/Oder.
 - e. In the course of the next few days, Frankfurt/Oder will dispatch 200 R and X cars, plus 100 S cars, to Brest-Litovsk.

2. The following trains of empty flatcars were dispatched:
 - a. On 18 February, 29 cars were dispatched from Zwickau to Neustrelitz, 35 cars from Zerbst to Eberswalde, and 20 cars from Bitterfeld to Neustrelitz.
 - b. On 19 February, one train of 43 cars and one train of 44 cars were dispatched from Zerbst to Eberswalde.
